### **Eligibility**

### **Position Description**

Prime Function / Key Responsibilities:

Leads the multidisciplinary team to provide specialist anaesthesia services to patients. Promotes patient safety and quality of care. Provides leadership, orientation, training, supervision and education, where relevant, for doctors in training, Health Service Medical Practitioners and other health workers. In collaboration with the Head of Department and other Consultants works to achieve National, State and NMHS performance standards and targets. Works within the scope of clinical practice as defined and recommended by the Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital Medical Credentialing and Scope of Clinical Practice Committee.

### **Essential Selection Criteria**

Applicants are referred to the JDF for the position.

1. Eligible for registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency as a specialist Anaesthetist.
2. Demonstrated extensive knowledge, clinical experience and skills in the practice of complex tertiary hospital Anaesthesia, including in anaesthesia conducted outside of the operating theatre such as for interventional cardiology, neuro-interventional, radiological and therapeutic endoscopic procedures.
3. Demonstrated experience and commitment to clinical teaching and clinical research.
4. Demonstrated knowledge and application of quality improvement principles and practices.
5. Demonstrated ability to provide leadership, facilitate effective multidisciplinary teamwork and provide patient-centred care.
6. Demonstrated high level communication, interpersonal, negotiation and conflict resolution skills.
7. Current knowledge of legislative obligations for Equal Opportunity, Disability Services and Occupational Safety and Health, and how these impact on employment and service delivery.
